



## REFEREE CODES

CODE	YELLOW CARD OFFENCES
Y1	Is guilty of unsporting behaviour.
Y2	Shows dissent by word or action.
Y3	Persistently infringes the Laws of the Game.
Y4	Delays the restart of play.
Y5	Fails to respect the required distance when play is restarted with a corner kick, free kick or throw-in.
Y6	Enters or re-enters the field of play without the Referee's permission.
Y7	Deliberately leaves the field of play without the Referee's permission.

CODE	RED CARD OFFENCES
R1	Is guilty of serious foul play.
R2	Is guilty of violent conduct.
R3	Spits at an opponent or any other person.
R4	Denies an opponent a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball.
R5	Denies an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the player's goal by an offence punishable by a free kick or a penalty kick.
R6	Uses offensive or insulting or abusive language and/or gestures.
R7	Receives a second caution in the same match.

## HUNTER CHRISTIAN CHURCHES FOOTBALL CODE OF CONDUCT & AGREEMENT

**The executive of your Football Club has agreed on behalf of the members of your club to uphold and enforce the Code of Conduct of HUNTER CHRISTIAN CHURCHES FOOTBALL INC. (referred to herein as the "Association") and they understand that if this document is not adhered to, club expulsion from the competition could follow.**

**Such code is as follows :**

1. To provide an environment through playing football which is competitive and played in a friendly spirit, through which people may come to know the Lord Jesus Christ.
2. All members of our club shall be made aware of this agreement and the conditions therein as to our continued membership of the Association.
3. Ensure that all aspects of our club's activities comply with the Constitution, Rules, Standing Orders and By-Laws of the Association.
4. Expect all players, spectators and club officials to adhere to requirements in the Association Member Protection Policy, particularly in relation to child protection.
5. Expect all players and spectators to have an attitude of respect towards the decisions of referees, associate referees whether official or unofficial.
6. Expect all players and spectators to show respect for players and spectators of opposing teams.
7. Expect all players, officials & spectators to conduct themselves in a manner, which will not bring disrepute to them or the Association.
8. Expect and seek from the Association all support where required to assist in the overall running of the Association.
9. Provide opportunity for all players to develop their skills in the game of football and knowledge of the Laws of the Game.
10. To encourage the ideals of a competitive attitude whilst ensuring a fair and balanced approach to our game.
11. To provide delegates to attend all Association meetings.
12. To guarantee payment of all fees by the due date.
13. To ensure that alcohol will NOT be brought to/consumed at any ground or it's surrounding areas.

**Above all encourage the fellowship and ideals of the Association and assist in its development and growth.**
